## HOW TO BECOME A BCBA:

- Obtain a Masters degree in approved field
- Complete fieldwork requirements
- Pass board certification exam
- Meet continuing education requirements
- Adhere to ethics requirements
- Recertify every two years
- Complete in person supervision and program modification with RBTs and clients



## WHAT IS A BEHAVIOR ANALYST?

A Board Certified Behavior Analyst® (BCBA®) is a graduate-level certification in behavior analysis.

Professionals certified at the BCBA level are independent practitioners who provide behavior-analytic services. BCBAs may supervise the work of Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analysts® (BCaBAs®), Registered Behavior Technicians® (RBTs®), and other professionals who implement behavior-analytic interventions.

## JOB REQUIREMENTS

- Conduct behavior assessments (FBA)
- Design individualized client program
- Review program effectiveness
- Make clinical recommendations, monitor data collection, and monitor client progress
- Facilitate parent training and support RBTs to ensure treatment integrity
- Communicate regularly with staff and parents
- Complete individualized comprehensive treatment plans
- Supervise and assist in training RBTs
- Provide meaningful feedback to RBTs
- Collaborate with colleagues and other service providers (SLPs, teachers, etc.)
- Manage individual schedule
